#### RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend that the City Council open the public hearing and approve, on first reading, the FY2023 Budget Ordinance Amendment to appropriate \$575,000 in fund balance to cover unbudgeted costs related to the Waste Management Contract that was recently approved in resolution No. 2022-54.

#### **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

The Department of Public Services issued bid specification for solid waste and recycling services on March 1, 2022, and one bid proposal was received from Waste Management of Rhode Island, Inc. The Council approved the award of contract to Waste Management on June 22, 2022. The pricing for the base year of the contract is \$2.45 million. The bid and awarded contract exceed what was budgeted by \$575,000.

This budget amendment appropriates \$575,000 from the general fund balance and would increase the appropriation lines per the fiscal impact below.

WHERBAS: The Director of Public Services requested sealed bid proposals for Solid Waste and Recycling Services, Bid #22-023, with bids received April 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS: Award has been recommended to the sole responsive bidder, Waste Management of Rhode Island, Inc., of Newport, RI, at its submitted bid prices; and

WHEREAS: Award shall be for a five (5) year period from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2027 subject to renewal, for three additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS: The contract pricing for the base contract year shall be \$2.45 million. The base contract costs will be negotiated and adjusted annually, on July 1 of each subsequent calendar year, beginning July 1, 2023. The basis for the adjustment will be the Consumer Price indices as outlined in the contract documents. There shall be a cap no less than zero percent (0%) decrease up to two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase, regardless of what the CPI indicates. NOW, THEREFFOE, BE IT

RESOLVED: That the bid received from Waste Management of Rhode Island, Inc., of Newport, RI is hereby accepted at a total not to exceed base contract cost of \$2.45 Million in year one; with second through fifth year not to exceed totals equal to the base contract total of \$2.45 million plus CPI adjustments per the contract language, and the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Newport, is authorized to sign said contract, subject to favorable review by the City Solicitor.
